

## Frassati Catholic Academy Tuition Contract Terms and Conditions – SY 2023-2024

### General Information

The payment of all prior years' tuition and fees must be current BEFORE registration will be accepted for the 2023–2024 school year. This includes payment for EDP services. **No child will be permitted to start school in August unless all the prior years' tuition and fees, including EDP, have been paid.**

### Tuition and Non-refundable School Fees

The non-refundable Registration Fee must be submitted at the time of registration. Failure to pay all tuition and related fees when due may result in your child(ren)'s exclusion from Frassati Catholic Academy, and Frassati Catholic Academy will take legal or collection action in order to collect these amounts from the responsible parties. Exclusion will begin on the first of the month, following the month of non-payment. **Please note all fees must be paid in full by the first day of school and cannot be rolled into your FACTS account.**

### Volunteering and Fundraising

PreK families are required to volunteer 10 hours per family throughout the year and participate in the annual Christmas Cash Raffle by selling 20 raffle tickets per family. K-8<sup>th</sup> families are required to volunteer 20 hours per family throughout the year and participate in the annual Christmas Cash Raffle by selling 20 raffle tickets per family. Options are available to “buy out” of providing service hours and selling raffle tickets on the Tuition Contract. If you have a Preschool student(s) and an elementary/middle school student, you are obligated to the K-8 fees and requirements only.

### FACTS Information

- **All new to Frassati Catholic Academy and RETURNING school families are required to use FACTS.** Families will need to log into FACTS via our website, <https://www.frassaticatholicacademy.org>, click the FACTS link located on homepage under Quick Links. **All families, including those who pay in full, MUST set up a payment plan within 10 days of receiving their Online Payment Plan Invitation.**
- Returning school families who used FACTS last year will be eligible for 'Electronic Reenrollment' and will not need to create a new plan. If you wish to change your payment plan, contact Tammy Kleckner at 847-526-6311.

### Frassati Family Association (FFA)

The Frassati Family Association (FFA) is a parent-led committee designed to support the school. Similar to a PTO, the FFA will raise money through fundraisers and events throughout the year. Funds raised by FFA go toward fieldtrips/assemblies, buses, teacher, classroom and school needs and support. **FFA will not be collecting an annual fee for the 2023-2024 SY at this time.**

### Preschool for All (PFA)

Families enrolled in our preschool are not eligible for multi-child discounts nor Tax Credit Scholarship (TCS). However, Frassati Catholic Academy hosts a Preschool for All program (PFA) within our school building. PFA is a program funded by the Illinois State Board of Education to provide a free, 2.5-hour preschool program for 3 (must be 3 years of age on or before Sept. 1) and 4-year-old children who qualify. ### PreK-8<sup>th</sup> Grade Extended Day Program (EDP)

Families with student(s) in grades PreK through 8<sup>th</sup> grade who choose to use our Extended Day Program (EDP) are required to pay an annual \$10.00 registration fee to use the program. This fee will be applied to the first EDP bill of the year. EDP is billed bi-weekly based on usage. Payment is due at the time families are billed. Any past due balances from the previous month will be rolled into your FACTS account automatically. The EDP is available daily 6:30am – start of school and after school until 6:00pm. The rate is \$5/hour/child, billed on a bi-weekly basis.
