Remote Learning
Handbook



ISBE has indicated that students should receive five (5) hours of academic learning time. This does not mean 5 hours of screen time, but (5) hours of learning time.

Teachers can provide lessons in a variety of ways.

- Livestream short lessons of direct instruction
- Recorded lessons of direct instruction
- Zoom check in (office hours)
- Activities and instructions for students to work through independently

Students will be provided their lesson directions and communication through two learning management systems.

- PK-3rd grade Seesaw
- 4th-8th grade Google Classroom

Students will be provided instruction in Core subjects.

- Reading/Language Arts
- Math
- Science
- Social Studies
- Religion

Students will be exempt from all specials

- Art
- Music
- Spanish
- Library
- Technology
- PE

Students and families should plan to be available during the school day. Classes will be run as they would at school. Teachers will ask you to join live periodically during the scheduled session.

Grading

- Students will be expected to adhere to turn in dates and will be graded as students learning in person.
- Teachers will provide regular feedback on assignments.

Materials

- Families should plan to pick materials up in 2 week increments at school. Staff will coordinate pick up times.

Technology

- Devices will be provided to those who request them. Seesaw, Google Classroom and other programs are web based and can be accessed on home devices.

August 20, 2020 .

- Teachers will reach out to their remote learning cohort and will set up a zoom for students to learn about the Learning Management platform, how classes will be set up, and how to contact the teacher.

Prior to August 20th, families will make an appointment for the afternoon or evening of August 18th or 19th to pick up student materials.
