In an effort to ensure our school communities are living out Christ centered behavior and values, we are excited to introduce our new positive behavior plan based on the Beatitudes. Living the Beatitudes was an important part of Blessed Pier Giorgio Frassati's life and it is an experience we want to ensure for all of our students at Frassati Catholic Academy. The program will recognize students' positive behaviors, efforts and achievements.

When a staff member observes a student in grades Prek-5 demonstrating one of the Beatitudes they will write the student's name on a bee which will be displayed on a bulletin board beehive.

Students in grades 6-8 will also be recognized for their positive behavior and academic achievements. At the end of each trimester, those junior high students who have passed all their classes and had two or less detentions will be able to participate in fun community building activities, which might include such things as a field trip, dance or movie day.
