Attention all students with special talents!! The Wauconda Campus Talent Show is Coming!!!

FCA will be hosting a talent show for the students on the Wauconda Campus. The purpose of this event is to demonstrate positive alternatives to negative behaviors.

The Talent Show will be held on Friday, April 26th at 1:30pm. We are looking for students with special talents who are willing to share them with the rest of the school. Some examples of talent would be:

- playing a musical instrument
- singing (group or individual)
- dancing (group or individual)
- comic routines
- hobby talents

Enclosed with this letter is a permission/sign-up sheet. Make sure you fill it out completely and turn it in by Tuesday, April 2nd. Try-Outs will be held on Thursday, April 4th from 3:30-4:15. Please come to the gym to pick up your child. **At the try-out, you must be prepared with your routine in its entirety. You must wear whatever costume you plan on wearing for the show.** The school will provide nothing (except a piano, music stand, mats, or CD player) for your act. You must acquire whatever you need yourself.

Act requirements:

1. The act should be no longer than 3 min. If you are dancing or singing to a song that lasts a few seconds longer, that will be permitted.
2. Music (song lyrics) must be appropriate to a Catholic school.
3. Costumes must be appropriate for a Catholic school.
4. Dance movements must be appropriate for a Catholic school.
5. Comic routines may not contain jokes inappropriate for a Catholic school.
6. You may only try out for one act.

If you fail to meet even one of the six act requirements, your act will be rejected. There will be no second tryouts. Everyone who turns in a sheet will be allowed to tryout.
